We thought you might like to know more about this great volunteer drivers service, especially useful when times are so hard. Volunteers take people to wherever they need to go in South Warwickshire and Rugby for all their medical needs, blood tests, dental and optician appointments and hospital discharge. You can also be taken to visit family in hospital and care homes. The service is an absolute boon for people living on their own and without transport.

Volunteers use their own cars, drivers' licences are checked, and vehicles are up to standard. The cars can carry wheelchairs although they are not currently wheelchair accessible. The service costs £3 plus petrol.
